

AIR QUALITY PERMIT NOTICE

Notice of Application

Notice is given that Carbonyx International USA Inc. has applied to the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Air Quality, for a Construction Permit, for a Carbon Alloy facility located on Route 2 adjacent to the Jackson County Maritime Industrial Centre, Millwood, West Virginia, 26164, in Jackson County, West Virginia.

The applicant estimates the potential to discharge the following Regulated Air Pollutants NO_x, SO_x, CO, Dust, VOC. The quantity of these pollutants will be below the minor source threshold limit set by the state.

Startup of operation is planned to begin on or about the 1st day of March, 2012. Written comments will be received by the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Air Quality, 601 57th Street, SE, Charleston, WV 25304, for at least 30 calendar days from the date of publication of this notice.
